Attention Fairfax Station NOVEC Customers/Residents!!!

The Fairfax Station Homeowners Association is pleased to announce, in cooperation with NOVEC officials, the launch of a neighborhood emergency Email notification program for any future power outages that may affect NOVEC residents.

In the event of a major outage, the Association will be notified within an hour by NOVEC officials to confirm the outage and will provide real time assessments for repairs and power restoration. We will then send out an Email with this information which can be accessed by any smart phone, tablet, or laptop that does not rely solely on your in home internet service/electricity. Specified periodic status updates will continue until power is restored.

If you would like to receive this service you must update the FSHOA data base with an Email address that you can access through a satellite based service (AT&T, Verizon, etc.) on your smart phones or tablets. You can send your contact information to us at comments@fshoa-va.com.

Our goal in establishing this unique program is to provide our community with accurate and timely information so that each family can assess their own contingency plan. For NOVEC residents that do not have smart phone or tablet capabilities, please contact a neighbor that does and receive the updates through them. We also encourage that you still call in any outages or blinks as they occur to ensure NOVEC has received current and proper notification.

For our *Dominion residents* that experienced an outage during the 'derecho' event, we are still investigating with DVP and should have answers sometime in October regarding efforts to reduce outages in the future.
